- Artistic training or education in any media
- Community development experience
- Strong project management skills

- Group facilitation experience
- Excellent communication skills
- Enthusiasm and willingness to learn
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Adaptability
- Creativity and organization
- Assertiveness
- Dedication

AS A PHA VISITING ARTIST, IN THE FIELD, YOU WILL BE EXPECTED TO:

- Be passionate and committed to the PHA mission, values & goals
- Communicate clearly in the national language (French, Haitian Kreyol or English) with your partner organization and community
- Creatively inspire community participation, leadership and development
- Facilitate the use of arts-based techniques in your partner organization's work
- Build sustainability into the design of all of your projects, using locally available resources, transferring knowledge to local leaders
- Adapt to the local people, culture and community while sensitively offering new ideas for collaboration
- Resolve personal and professional conflicts with grace and openness
- Document your work through an annual plan, online projects, blog posts, photos, video, evaluation, etc.

- An emergency reserve (recommended)
